- Members of Public Health Service, Environmental Science Services Administration, and other organizations when assigned to and serving with the Navy

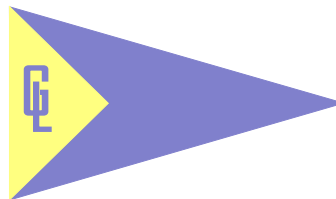
Note: Membership does not, in and of itself, entitle the member or dependents to the use of other base recreational facilities.

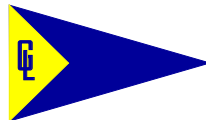
